## Indications on the instrument



## Pay attention to the finish of the chosen instrument

We cannot guarantee the results on instruments with a glossy finish because the thicker nitro varnish will tend to trigger small flashes that may create small bubbles or lines that are not always clear.

### Always consider the shape of your ukulele.

The graphic must respect a safety margin around the printing surface following the contours of the tool to avoid being cut.

#### Remember the orientation of the graphics.

If you play left-handed, graphics printed "right-handed" may appear upside down. So remember to specify the direction of orientation.

#### We guarantee excellent results on wood only.

The laser works very well on all natural wood species, but we do not guarantee the same results on plastic or other materials.

## **Formato file**



### Graphics must be in black and white.

The laser is not able to reproduce colours, so it will be useful to already receive a black and white graphic with possible shades of grey.

#### The size of the lettering must not be less than 9 pt.

Smaller sizes would be too small for printing.

#### Use the correct resolution.

In order to guarantee a detailed print you will need a high resolution graphic of the chosen size and with at least 250 DPI .  $^{\odot}$ 



DPI is the unit of measurement for the amount of ink dots a printer can deposit per inch. It is a value that many graphics software can vary to suit your needs. With low dpi values the print may not be accurate and some pixels may be visible. a high resolution graphic of the chosen size and with at least 250 DPI.

The graphics file must be sent in TIF, JPG, PNG or PDF format.
